The Frog Pub and Restaurant, Camberley



The Frog in Camberley is a pub run by Hall & Woodhouse, the Dorset based brewer of Badger beer with 190 pubs spread across the south of England.

The Frog is a 'Template' pub along the same lines as The Holly Blue in Basingstoke. Overall architecture was provided by Mackenzie Wheeler Architects alongside interior architects Carter Lauren.



Along with traditional B&B, precast planks at first floor and timber truss roof structure, the building features a unique steel frame solution allowing the beams to be prominent features which contrast with the traditional oak connections of the dining hall and outdoor seating area.

The works comprised of the construction of the Savoy Cinema and multiple restaurants (including Nando's and Prezzo Italian) to serve the local Corby community.

Challenges included contaminated ground and the design of a curved roof and walls. By treating the contaminated ground we were able to avoid disposal off site and surface water management proposal to comply with EA guidelines for SUDS.

With the use of new materials and construction technology we were able to design the curved walls and roof features specified by the Client, Mulberry Developments.
